7. Items Brought Up by Council Members
  - a. How can the school better empower parents with data, training, and resources to allow them to take a more proactive role in helping with their children's education?

- i. They would like more granular data regarding student academic levels and what the specific next step is to help them (*i.e. if their child is reading below level they would like to know how to help more than the general recommendation to “read with your child”.* )
- ii. Parent Teacher Conferences typically provide general information, but don’t provide parents with actional information regarding how/what they can help with at home.
- iii. Is there a way to get more specific real-time information to parents that doesn’t put an unreasonable expectation on teacher’s time? Parents know they can call the teacher to get specific information, but would love for there to be a way for them to get that information without taking up more of the teacher’s time.
