Agenda Items:

1. Jordan Parent Council Meeting Update – Dan Carlson.

One item that was discussed was suicide prevention measures / resources – Parent Guidance.org. Free counseling services, parent coaching is provided. There is a link on the Jordan District website. The school Reunification plan was also discussed and there is a video that shows parents more information.

2. Approve minutes from our prior meeting, December 1 2022. Nick Hansen displayed the prior minutes and summarized. Nick motioned to approve the minutes. Ashley Pack seconded the motion. All raised hands in agreement to approve. Minutes approved.

3. Review Acadience Test Scores. Rebecca Atwell, instructional coach at West Jordan Elementary School introduced herself, she will be assigned to our school until the end of the year. Current Acadience scores were shared with the group. Reviewed scores for each grade K-6 for Golden Fields, compared results from the Beginning of the year and the Middle of the year. Dan reminded us of the goal with the SCC improvement rate of 2%, and thus far our results are showing a 3% improvement from last year. Ann posed the question as to whether our future goals could focus on math score improvement. Chris pointed out that reading is one area of education where there is actual empirical

data on successful teaching methods, whereas math is a little trickier to measure because different methods work for different individuals. Dan also cautioned that we haven't met our overall goal of improving our reading scores to a certain level, so while we have made progress, may not be time to change the goal to math, since reading score improvement is still needed.

4. **Review of Walk to Read Program changes and implementation.** Discussed the new process where slips of paper are sent home with students every 3 weeks to notify parents and guardians of student's skill level currently being worked on in Walk To Read. Most parent committee members acknowledged that they've been receiving this information and it is helpful with the tie in on the website to the recommended activities for parents to try with students at home.
5. **New Business** – Update from Nick Hansen on discussion regarding safety concerns with the flow of traffic surrounding Golden Fields. He indicated he will be making requests to district for additional signs showing vehicles where to pull up for drop off/pick up, also sharing concerns with city on congestion on Split Rock, cars parking in no parking areas, facing the wrong way, etc. Asking if signage can be lowered so it can be seen easier. Additional crosswalk on Split Rock? Possible left turn lane in front of school where vehicles back up in the one lane?
6. **Next Meeting** – March 8th. Group will review and discuss the plan for next year.

Meeting end time 5:20 pm. Holli Wilson motioned to adjourn the meeting. Cristie seconded the motion. All were in favor.
